Eligibility:

Applicants must meet ALL of the following criteria:

- Work at an ELC center accepting state subsidies for at least six months prior to the current 2021-2022 school year.
- Work must be started and completed between July 1, 2021- April 30, 2022.
- Must complete a <u>Professional Growth Plan</u>; then complete the work for one of the following paths; Professional Development, Higher Education or a Permit Attainment/Advancement.
