QCC Mono/Alpine Workforce Pathways Stipend Program (WPSP): The Workforce Pathways Grant was designed to focus on staff retention. The goal is to build upon and reinforce the early learning and care workforce through a workforce advising team. The workforce advising team focuses on requirements to establish a professional growth plan, meet with the advisor 2-3 times that year and complete one professional growth hours in one of the following ways; professional development, degree attainment and attainment or advancement on the CA Child Development Permit Matrix. If a provider successfully completes this program, they will be eligible for a stipend based on their level of completion.
